- In addition to the electronic copy, I would also like a hard copy of the form (please talk to the Office of International Student Services **prior** to paying for the courier services). This is true both for domestic and international addresses. If you choose this route, you must, first, certify that you live at that address.
- I will come in person to pick up my I-20. (Photo ID will be required). Please note that this option is subject to change.
