

Estimated Expenses for the Nursing Program

Costs will vary according to your personal situation. Our electronic resources include all textbooks for the program and other required computer-based products, including case studies, electronic medical records, and a suite of simulation resources and standardized testing.

Variable expenses depend on what types of computer devices you already own, and whether you plan to purchase new or used uniforms or have already worked in healthcare and have some of the needed supplies. If you have health care coverage, the expense of a physical exam and immunizations will be different than for a student who must pay out of pocket for those services.
